

Unit 32 | Session 4 **PETER WAS RESCUED FROM PRISON** Acts 12

King Herod Agrippa was persecuting believers in the church. He killed James, one of Jesus' apostles. He arrested Peter too. While Peter was in prison, other believers in the church prayed and asked God to help him.

The night before his trial, Peter was sleeping between two soldiers. He was in chains. All of a sudden, an angel of the Lord appeared.

"Quick, get up!" the angel said. The chains fell off of Peter's wrists. The angel told Peter to get dressed. Then he followed the angel.

The angel led Peter out of the prison, past the guards, through the gate, and onto the streets. Then the angel left. When Peter looked around, he realized the Lord had rescued him from prison and from certain death! Peter hurried to the house of Mary, the mother of John Mark, where the believers had gathered to pray. When Peter knocked at the door, a servant named Rhoda answered. She heard Peter's voice and she was so happy she rushed back inside, leaving Peter standing outside. "Peter is here! He is at the door!" she announced.

But the others didn't believe her. "You're crazy!" they said. When they opened the door, they could hardly believe it. Peter motioned to them to be quiet, and he told them how the Lord had rescued him from prison.
